

Applying to Kindergarten in District 7

Apply between January 22 and March 1, 2013

How does it work?

- **There are no longer any zoned elementary schools in District 7.** In November, the District 7 Community Education Council approved a plan to make District 7 an elementary choice district.
- **District 7 has two areas: North and South.** Families may apply to all District 7 schools, but will have a better chance of being admitted to schools in the area where they live.
- **Admission is NOT first-come, first-served.** All applications received by the deadline are treated the same, according to the District 7 admissions priorities.



Who is eligible?

Children born in 2008 who reside in New York City.

How can families apply?

Beginning **January 22**, you can apply in three ways:

- **Online** at www.nyc.gov/schools/kindergarten
- **In person** at the Bronx Enrollment Office, 1 Fordham Plaza, 7th Floor.
(8 am – 3 pm, Mon - Fri)
- **Over the phone** by calling 718-935-2009 (Hours: 8 am – 6 pm, Mon – Fri)

Applications must be submitted no later than March 1, 2013.
